After critical and audience rave reviews and sold out shows, Theatre by the River has scheduled three additional performances of Sean Reycraft's *One Good Marriage*. Winnipeggers who missed the original production will be able to catch it at Aqua Books on September 22nd as part of the bookstore/cultural hub's *Best of Fest* series. TBTR is also pleased to be adding two rural shows, performing in late autumn (dates TBA) in Bruxelles, Manitoba as a joint fundraiser with the Bruxelles Community Development Committee.

In *One Good Marriage* by Sean Reycraft actors Matthew TenBruggencate and Mel Marginet (under the direction of James Firby) portray a couple marking their first year anniversary and looking back at the astonishing tragedy that changed their lives...and their marriage. The Winnipeg Fringe production earned 5 stars from *Winnipeg Free Press* reviewer Wendy Burke who said the show was "Fringe style theatre at it's finest. It's too quirky for a mainstage, yet gloriously at home on the edge."
